The transcripts were due July 26, 2010. The appellant has informed the court that as of August 16, 2010, the transcripts for the July 23-25, 2008 hearings have not been filed. The district court docket notes proceedings on those dates reported by Court Reporter John Turman and confirms the appellant's representation regarding the reporter's default.

Within 21 days after the date of this order, Court Reporter Turman shall file the transcripts, file a motion for extension of time to do so, or inform the court in writing of any barriers to transcript production.

If the reporter has previously filed transcripts for all hearings he reported or if the reporter did not report any proceedings in this case, he shall notify this court and the court reporter supervisor in writing.

The appellant shall inform this court by letter within 35 days after the date of this order if the original transcripts have not been filed in the district court. *See* 9th Cir. R. 11-1.2.

In the absence of further information regarding an incomplete record, the following briefing schedule shall govern: the first cross-appeal brief is due October 20, 2010; the second cross-appeal brief is due November 19, 2010; the third cross-appeal brief is due December 20, 2010; and the optional reply brief is due within 14 days after service of the answering brief.

This order shall be provided to the court reporter at the district court; a copy of this order to Manager of Court Reporting Services Blanca Aguilar.

Counsel is reminded that this court requires a notice of court reporter default must be served on the court reporter supervisor. 9th Cir. R. 11-1.2. If counsel has not previously done so, counsel shall serve a copy of the notice on Manager of Court Reporting Services Blanca Aguilar within 7 days after the date of this order.
