3 4. All prior financial obligations of the defendant, including
4 any special assessments, shall be vacated, aside from the \$2,500 fine
5 imposed per the parties' Stipulation and Letter Agreement.

6 5. At end of diversion period set forth in the parties'
7 Stipulation and Letter Agreement, the government shall file a motion
8 to dismiss in accord with those agreements, or alternatively file a
9 report with the Court regarding the status of defendant's compliance
10 with the terms of the Letter Agreement.


